5 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SURPLUS PERSONAL  
6 PROPERTY OF THE CITY; DECLARING THAT CERTAIN

8 VEHICLE NUMBER 8103-20) VALUED AT \$4,875, 2010  
9 CHEVROLET IMPALA (VIN 2G1WD5EM6A1232110,  
10 VEHICLE NUMBER 209-30) VALUED AT \$4,500, 2011  
11 CHEVROLET IMPALA (VIN 2G1WD5EMXB1189974,

19 SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY AND  
20 AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS OF THE  
21 CITY TO TRANSFER TITLE OF SAID PROPERTY TO  
22 NASSAU COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD, LOCATED AT 1201  
23 ATLANTIC AVENUE, FERNANDINA BEACH, FLORIDA  
24 32034, FOR USE AS PART OF AN ASSIGNED VEHICLE  
25 PROGRAM FOR THE NASSAU COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT  
26 POLICE, AT NO COST, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION  
27 122.812(C), *ORDINANCE CODE*; DESIGNATING THE  
28 FLEET MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE FINANCE AND  
29 ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT TO MONITOR ACTUAL  
30 USE OF SAID PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR A  
31 REVERTER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

1           **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

2           **Section 1.           Declaration of Surplus.**       The City hereby  
3 declares that certain 2010 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2G1WA5EK2A1199839,  
4 vehicle number 8103-20) valued at \$4,875, 2010 Chevrolet Impala  
5 (VIN 2G1WD5EM6A1232110, vehicle number 209-30) valued at \$4,500,  
6 2011 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2G1WD5EMXB1189974, vehicle number 169-  
7 30) valued at \$5,300, 2011 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2G1WD5EM4B1185838,  
8 vehicle number 0185-40) valued at \$4,750, 2012 Chevrolet Caprice  
9 (VIN 6G1MK5U3XCL638817, vehicle number 1010-30) valued at \$8,325,  
10 and 2012 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2G1WD5E33C1197441, vehicle number  
11 4797-20) valued at \$4,825, as more particularly described in  
12 **Exhibit 1** attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference  
13 ("Subject Property"), to be surplus to the needs of the City of  
14 Jacksonville and authorizes the appropriate City officials to  
15 transfer title of the Subject Property to Nassau County School  
16 Board, located at 1201 Atlantic Avenue, Fernandina Beach, Florida  
17 32034, at no cost, pursuant to Section 122.812(c), *Ordinance Code*.  
18 A copy of the certificate from the Chief of Procurement certifying  
19 compliance with provisions of Chapter 122, *Ordinance Code*, is  
20 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, and incorporated herein by this  
21 reference.   A copy of the property transfer forms is attached  
22 hereto as **Exhibit 3**.

23           **Section 2.           Public Purpose.**       The surplus vehicle is needed  
24 by the Nassau County School Board to be used as part of an assigned  
25 vehicle program for the Nassau County School District Police. The  
26 City of Jacksonville finds that providing the surplussed vehicle to  
27 the Nassau County School Board to be used as part of an assigned  
28 vehicle program for the Nassau County School District Police is a  
29 valid public purpose.

30           **Section 3.           Fleet Management Division to Monitor Actual**  
31 **Use of Subject Property.**   The Fleet Management Division of the

1 Finance and Administration Department will be the designated agency  
2 to monitor the Nassau County School Board's use of the Subject  
3 Property in accordance with the purposes set forth herein.

4       **Section 4. Reverter.** The disposition authorized herein  
5 is conditioned upon the Nassau County School Board using the said  
6 vehicle for the purposes set forth herein and is conditioned upon  
7 the Nassau County School Board agreeing to convey the vehicle back  
8 to the City of Jacksonville in the event that the vehicle is not  
9 used for those purposes.

10       **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
11 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
12 without the Mayor's signature.
