RESOLUTION 2019-594-A

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL DESIGNATING A PORTION OF U.S. ROUTE 90 BETWEEN YELLOW WATER ROAD AND LOG ROAD IN DUVAL COUNTY AS "TROOPER ROBERT Р. MCDERMON MEMORIAL HIGHWAY"; DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES TO SEND A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, DUVAL LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION, THE FLORIDA SENATE PRESIDENT AND THE SPEAKER OF THE FLORIDA HOUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, during the 2019 Legislative Session, the Florida Legislature passed House Bill 0385, which makes honorary designations of transportation facilities throughout Florida and directs the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to erect suitable makers for those designations; and

WHEREAS, House Bill 0385 designates that portion of U.S. Route (72010000) between Yellow Water Road and Log Road in Duval County as "Trooper Robert P. McDermon Memorial Highway"; and

WHEREAS, Section 334.071, Florida Statutes, provides that a city or county must pass a resolution in support of a particular designation before road markers are erected; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville wishes to honor Trooper Robert P. McDermon and requests that the Florida Department of Transportation erect suitable markers designating a portion of U.S.

Route 90 (72010000) between Yellow Water Road and Log Road in Duval County as "Trooper Robert P. McDermon Memorial Highway"; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville strongly supports House Bill 0385, and designation of a portion of U.S. Route 90 (72010000) between Yellow Water Road and Log Road in Duval County as the "Trooper Robert P. McDermon Memorial Highway," and hereby authorizes the erection of appropriate signage by the Florida Department of Transportation to commemorate the designation.

Section 2. Direction to Chief of Legislative Services.

The Chief of Legislative Services for the City Council is hereby directed to provide a copy of this Resolution to the Florida Department of Transportation, Duval County Legislative Delegation, Florida Senate President and Speaker of the Florida House.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
