9 TO THE JACKSONVILLE FILM & TELEVISION JOB &
10 BUSINESS CREATION INCENTIVE PROGRAM WITHIN THE
11 PUBLIC INVESTMENT POLICY OF THE OFFICE OF
12 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE
13 2019-243-E, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 19-108;
14 PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2018-2019 fiscal year,
18 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
19 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
20 the accounts listed in subsection (b):

28 Appropriating \$50,000 of available funds from the
29 Countywide Economic Development-II Project to subsidies
30 and contributions to private organizations to fund the

1 Jacksonville Film & Television Job & Business Creation
2 Incentive Program (the "Program").

3 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
4 Section 1 is to provide funding to implement the Program, which
5 allows for a 10% rebate to eligible film and television production
6 companies for qualified expenditures in Duval County. To be
7 eligible for the 10% rebate authorized by the incentive, a company
8 must have a minimum of \$50,000 of qualified expenditures, with a
9 maximum reimbursement of up to \$50,000. The Program is a part of
10 the Public Investment Policy of the Office of Economic Development,
11 as amended by Ordinance 2019-243-E.

12 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
13 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
14 without the Mayor's signature.
