4 **ORDINANCE 2019-474**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE
6 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
7 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON
8 BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
9 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE CITY
10 OF JACKSONVILLE BEACH FOR ADVANCED LIFE
11 SUPPORT AND FIRE SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR CITY
12 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE
13 DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING POSITIONS, AS
14 INITIATED BY R.C. 20-004; PROVIDING AN
15 EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
19 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation
20 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on
21 behalf of the City, the Interlocal Agreement between the City of
22 Jacksonville and the City of Jacksonville Beach for Advanced Life
23 Support and Fire Services (the "Agreement"), a copy of which has
24 been placed **ON FILE** with the Office of Legislative Services.
25 Pursuant to the Agreement, the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue
26 Department ("JFRD") will provide Advanced Life Support and Fire
27 Services to Jacksonville Beach by placing one full-time engine
28 company and one full-time ladder company in Jacksonville Beach fire
29 stations and providing other ancillary services normally provided
30 by JFRD and its associated divisions (the "Services"). JFRD shall

1 provide the Services twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a
2 week in accordance with the Agreement. The term of the Agreement
3 shall commence as of its effective date and run for a period of
4 twenty (20) years unless terminated earlier by either party.
5 Jacksonville Beach shall pay to the City of Jacksonville
6 \$2,220,000.00 for the first year of the Agreement and said amount
7 shall be increased each year thereafter by 2.5% or the annual
8 percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index, whichever is
9 greater. All current fire department employees of Jacksonville
10 Beach shall become employees of the City of Jacksonville on the
11 effective date of the Agreement, provided all of the certifications
12 and requirements of Chapter 633, Florida Statutes, are met. Twenty-
13 eight (28) full-time employee positions shall be added as set forth
14 in Exhibit E of the Agreement. This centralized and coordinated
15 delivery of the Services throughout the county will benefit both
16 parties and provide effective, efficient delivery of public safety
17 services to the residents and businesses of Duval County.

18 **Section 2. Oversight.** JFRD shall oversee the
19 Services.

20 **Section 3. Authorization of positions.** There are
21 hereby authorized the positions more fully described in R.C. 20-
22 004, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this
23 reference.

24 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
25 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
26 without the Mayor's signature.
