6 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE  
7 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION  
8 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON  
9 BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT  
10 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE CITY  
11 OF JACKSONVILLE BEACH FOR ADVANCED LIFE  
12 SUPPORT AND FIRE SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR CITY  
13 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE  
14 DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING POSITIONS, AS  
15 INITIATED BY R.C. 20-004; PROVIDING FOR REVIEW  
16 OF INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AND AMENDMENTS THERETO  
17 NO LESS THAN EVERY THREE YEARS; PROVIDING AN  
18 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby  
22 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation  
23 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on  
24 behalf of the City, the Interlocal Agreement between the City of  
25 Jacksonville and the City of Jacksonville Beach for Advanced Life  
26 Support and Fire Services (the "Agreement"), a copy of which has  
27 been placed **Revised On File** with the Office of Legislative  
28 Services. Pursuant to the Agreement, the Jacksonville Fire and  
29 Rescue Department ("JFRD") will provide Advanced Life Support and  
30 Fire Services to Jacksonville Beach by placing one full-time engine

1 company and one full-time ladder company in Jacksonville Beach fire  
2 stations and providing other ancillary services normally provided  
3 by JFRD and its associated divisions (the "Services"). JFRD shall  
4 provide the Services twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a  
5 week in accordance with the Agreement. The term of the Agreement  
6 shall commence as of its effective date and run for a period of  
7 twenty (20) years unless terminated earlier by either party.  
8 Jacksonville Beach shall pay to the City of Jacksonville  
9 \$2,220,000.00 for the first year of the Agreement and said amount  
10 shall be increased each year thereafter by 2.5% or the annual  
11 percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index, whichever is  
12 greater. All current fire department employees of Jacksonville  
13 Beach shall become employees of the City of Jacksonville on the  
14 effective date of the Agreement, provided all of the certifications  
15 and requirements of Chapter 633, Florida Statutes, are met. Twenty-  
16 eight (28) full-time employee positions shall be added as set forth  
17 in Exhibit E of the Agreement. This centralized and coordinated  
18 delivery of the Services throughout the county will benefit both  
19 parties and provide effective, efficient delivery of public safety  
20 services to the residents and businesses of Duval County.

21 **Section 2. Oversight.** JFRD shall oversee the  
22 Services.

23 **Section 3. Authorization of positions.** There are  
24 hereby authorized the positions more fully described in R.C. 20-  
25 004, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this  
26 reference.

27 **Section 4. Providing for Review of Interlocal Agreement**  
28 **and amendments thereto no less than every three years.** The City of  
29 Jacksonville shall review this Interlocal Agreement and any  
30 amendments thereto, with consideration given to both operational  
31 and financial impacts to the City of Jacksonville, no less than

1 every three years from the effective date of this ordinance. As  
2 part of this review, the City of Jacksonville shall ensure that all  
3 budgeted and actual expenditures and revenues related to providing  
4 fire services at Jacksonville Beach are separately tracked and that  
5 this information, as well as any recommendations from the City of  
6 Jacksonville, are distributed to the City Council Members.

7 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
8 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
9 without the Mayor's signature.
