AN ORDINANCE DECLARING PROPERTY LOCATED AT 5 1447 NORTH DAVIS STREET, R.E. NO(S) 054393-6 7 0000, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7, TO BE SURPLUS TO 8 THE NEEDS OF THE CITY; AUTHORIZING DISPOSITION 9 OF THE SUBJECT PARCEL BY DIRECT SALE TO ST. STEPHEN'S AFRICAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, 10 INC. IN CONSIDERATION OF IN KIND SERVICES 11 VALUED AT \$28,950.00; WAIVING SECTION 122.424 12 13 (APPRAISAL/ASSESSED VALUE OVER \$25,000), CHAPTER 122 (PUBLIC PROPERTY), ORDINANCE CODE; 14 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND 15 16 THE CORPORATION SECRETARY ΤO EXECUTE A QUITCLAIM DEED BETWEEN 17 THECITY OF 18 JACKSONVILLE AND ST. STEPHEN'S AFRICAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, 19 INC. FOR THE 20 TRANSFER OF THE CITY'S INTEREST ΤO ST. 21 STEPHEN'S AFRICAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, 22 INC. FOR THE PARCEL LOCATED AT 1447 NORTH 23 DAVIS STREET; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
Section 1. Declaration of Surplus. The City hereby
declares R.E. No. 054393-0000, 1447 North Davis Street, in Council
District 7, as more particularly described in Exhibit 1, attached
hereto and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Subject
Parcel"), to be surplus to the needs of the City of Jacksonville. A
copy of the certificate from the Chief of Real Estate for the

surplus of real property, required by Rule 3.102 (Preparation of
 Bills), is attached hereto as Exhibit 2.

3 Section 2. Sale of Surplus Property. The Subject Parcel will be disposed of by direct sale for the negotiated price of 4 5 \$27,950.00 to St. Stephen's African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc. According to the records of the Duval County Property 6 7 Appraiser, the 2018 in-progress assessed value of the property is \$27,812.00. The property has been maintained for thirteen years by 8 9 St. Stephen's African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc. and as owner 10 it will be responsible to continue so to do upon sale.

11 Section 3. Consideration. St. Stephen's African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc. has provided \$28,950.00 of in kind 12 services to the City of Jacksonville as follows: The Church has 13 14 maintained the grounds of the Subject Property for the past thirteen years, which if mowed by the City a minimum of four times 15 per year, would have cost the City \$5,200; and the Church also 16 17 allowed the City to use its property for construction staging for nineteen months at a value of \$1,250 per month for a total value of 18 19 \$23,750 to the City. The City accepts these in kind contributions 20 valued at \$28,950.00 as more fully described in **Exhibit 3** attached hereto, as good and valuable consideration for the 21 Subject 22 Property.

23 Section 4. Authorization to execute Quitclaim Deed. The 24 Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby 25 authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City a Quitclaim 26 Deed in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit 4, for 27 the transfer of the City's interest in the Subject Parcel to St. Stephen's African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc. The Quitclaim 28 deed includes a transfer of the City's interest for consideration 29 of use of St. Stephens African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc. 30 property by the City of a period of 19 months valued at \$1250 per 31

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1 month and the maintenance of the Subject parcel property for 2 thirteen years, as noted in Section 3.

Waiver of Section 122.424, Ordinance Code. 3 Section 5. Section 122.424 (Appraisal/Assessed Value Over \$25,000), Chapter 4 122 (Public Property), Ordinance Code, is hereby waived as to the 5 sealed competitive bid and auction requirements to allow a 6 7 negotiated sale to St. Stephen's African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc. in consideration for in kind services at 8 least 9 equivalent in value to the assessed value of the Subject Property.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
