## RESOLUTION 2019-402

A RESOLUTION HONORING AND CONGRATULATING REAR ADMIRAL SEAN S. BUCK, CURRENTLY COMMANDER OF THE U.S. NAVAL FORCES SOUTHERN COMMAND AND THE U.S. 4<sup>TH</sup> FLEET AT MAYPORT, ON HIS NOMINATION TO SERVE AS THE NEXT SUPERINTENDENT OF THE U.S. NAVAL ACADEMY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Rear Admiral Sean S. Buck, a native of Indianapolis, graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1983, holds a master's degree in international security policy from the George Washington University, and has studied at the College of Command and Staff at the U.S. Naval War College, the Armed Forces Staff College, the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and the Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University; and

WHEREAS, following graduation from the Naval Academy, Rear Admiral Buck became a pilot, flying the P-3C Orion in Patrol Squadron (VP) 40, did a sea tour on the USS Theodore Roosevelt (CVN 71), and subsequently commanded VP-26 and Patrol and Reconnaissance Wing 11; and

WHEREAS, his staff and shore assignments include the Bureau of Naval Personnel; the Joint Staff J3; Office of Naval Operations staff as executive assistant to the deputy chief of Naval Operations (CNO) for Warfare Requirements and Programs, N6/N7; and the U.S. Joint Forces Command as deputy director for Operations in the Strategy and Policy Directorate, J5; and

WHEREAS, most recently, Rear Admiral Buck has performed outstandingly as Commander of U.S. Naval Forces Southern Command

and the U.S. Fourth Fleet at Naval Station Mayport in Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, Rear Admiral Buck has recently been nominated to serve as the 63rd Superintendent of the U.S. Naval Academy, pending confirmation by the U.S. Senate; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby honors and congratulates Rear Admiral Sean S. Buck, currently Commander of U.S. Naval Forces Southern Command and the U.S. Fourth Fleet at Mayport, for his long and outstanding naval career, particularly his service here in Jacksonville, and wishes him the very best of success as the new Superintendent of the U.S. Naval Academy.
