AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR DISCLAIMING AN OPENED AND IMPROVED PORTION OF THE MAY STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY, ESTABLISHED IN DEED BOOK AJ, PAGE 723 OF THE FORMER PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7, AT THE REQUEST OF THE DOWNTOWN INVESTMENT AUTHORITY, SUBJECT TO RESERVATION UNTO JEA OF AN ALL UTILITIES EASEMENT OVER THE CLOSED PORTION OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR INGRESS AND EGRESS AND FOR ALL UTILITIES; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Closure and Abandonment. An opened and improved portion of the May Street right-of-way, established in Deed Book AJ, page 723 of the former public records of Duval County, in Council District 7, descriptions of which are attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby closed and abandoned and/or disclaimed as a right-of-way at the request of the Downtown Investment Authority (the "Applicant"); provided, however, there is reserved unto JEA an All Utilities Easement on, over, across, and under the closed right-of-way for ingress and egress and for all utilities, including but not limited to water, sewer, electric, and drainage, so as to provide JEA continued access to service infrastructure. There are no city, state, or other agency objections to this closure request.

abutting property owner on the northwest has approved of the closure request. No closure application fee has been paid as Applicant is exempt from the fee.

Section 2. Purpose. Applicant has requested the closure to facilitate the development of the abutting properties to the southeast of the right-of-way to be closed. The City acquired those abutting properties on the southeast by way of a road transfer map from the Florida Department of Transportation in 2010.

Section 3. Hold Harmless Covenant. The closure and abandonment by the City of its interests in the right-of-way is subject to the execution and delivery to the City by 2018 Leila Jax LLC ("Grantor") of a hold harmless covenant in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. Accordingly, the closure and abandonment of the right-of-way shall not be recorded in the Public Records until execution and delivery to the City by Grantor of the required hold harmless covenant.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
