5 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS
6 DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO (1)
7 EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE
8 CITY, (A) AN AGREEMENT WITH SHANDS
9 JACKSONVILLE MEDICAL CENTER, INC., AND (B) A
10 LETTER OF AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA
11 THROUGH ITS AGENCY FOR HEALTH CARE
12 ADMINISTRATION, BOTH CONCERNING PAYMENT AND
13 DISTRIBUTION OF THE CITY'S INDIGENT HEALTH
14 CARE FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$26,275,594 FOR
15 FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020, AND (2) TAKE SUCH
16 FURTHER ACTION AS MAY BE NECESSARY OR
17 APPROPRIATE TO EFFECTUATE THE PURPOSE OF THE
18 ORDINANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Authorization.** The Mayor, or his designee, and
22 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to: (1) execute and
23 deliver (a) an agreement between the City of Jacksonville and
24 Shands Jacksonville Medical Center, Inc. ("Shands"), in
25 substantially the same form as is attached hereto as **Revised**
26 **Exhibit 1**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev Shands Agmt,
27 September 17, 2019 - Finance", and incorporated herein by this
28 reference, and (b) letters of Agreement between the City of
29 Jacksonville and the State of Florida Agency for Health Care
30 Administration, in substantially the same form as is attached

1 hereto as **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev LIP
2 Agmt, September 17, 2019 - Finance" and **Revised Exhibit 3**, labeled
3 as "Revised Exhibit 3, Rev DSH Agmt, September 17, 2019 - Finance",
4 and incorporated herein by this reference, both of which concern
5 payment and distribution of the City's indigent health care funds
6 in the amount of \$26,275,594 for fiscal year 2019-2020 and, (2)
7 take such further action as may be necessary or appropriate to
8 effectuate the purpose of this ordinance. No agreements between the
9 City and the State of Florida, Agency for Health Care
10 Administration, will be executed and no funding disbursed by the
11 City to the State until the City confirms adequate participation in
12 the IGT program by other counties and government entities in the
13 State.

14 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of this Ordinance is to
15 provide for the distribution of the City's contribution to indigent
16 health care funding between Shands and the State of Florida as part
17 of the State's Medicaid Hospital Program.

18 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
20 without the Mayor's signature.
