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5 **ORDINANCE 2019-646-E**

6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$110,800 AS  
7 FOLLOWS: (1) \$20,000 FROM THE MAYOR'S  
8 EXECUTIVE OPERATING CONTINGENCY AND \$16,933  
9 FROM THE COUNCIL OPERATING CONTINGENCY TO  
10 PROVIDE FUNDING TO THE PUBLIC INFORMATION  
11 CAMPAIGN ON RETENTION PONDS; (2) \$20,000 FROM  
12 THE MAYOR'S EXECUTIVE OPERATING CONTINGENCY  
13 AND \$16,934 FROM THE COUNCIL OPERATING  
14 CONTINGENCY TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO VOLUNTEERS  
15 IN MEDICINE JACKSONVILLE, INC. ("VOLUNTEERS")  
16 TO SERVE PATIENTS IN THE CITY WITHIN THE 32210  
17 ZIP CODE AREA; AND (3) \$20,000 FROM THE  
18 MAYOR'S EXECUTIVE OPERATING CONTINGENCY AND  
19 \$16,933 FROM THE COUNCIL OPERATING CONTINGENCY  
20 TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF  
21 NORTH FLORIDA, INC. ("GOODWILL") TO SUPPORT  
22 GOODWILL'S ADULT WORKFORCE PREPARATION  
23 PROGRAM, ALL AS INITIATED BY B.T. 19-118;  
24 PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO FISCAL  
25 YEAR 2019-2020; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION TO  
26 SECTION 126.107(g), *ORDINANCE CODE*; APPROVING  
27 AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CORPORATION  
28 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON  
29 BEHALF OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY"),  
30 THE FUNDING AGREEMENTS WITH VOLUNTEERS AND

GOODWILL, RESPECTIVELY, TO PARTIALLY FUND THE FOREGOING PROGRAMS AND SERVICES; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF GRANTS AND COMPLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2018-2019 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the accounts(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is a transfer of surplus funds from the General Fund/General Services District - Mayor's Executive Operating Contingency, and from the General Fund/General Services District- Council Operating Contingency, to advertising and promotion to provide funding for a public information campaign on retention ponds and subsidies and contributions to private sources to partially fund Volunteers in Medicine Jacksonville, Inc.'s ("Volunteers") expansion of services in the 32210 zip code to serve an additional patient population and partially fund Goodwill Industries of North Florida, Inc.'s ("Goodwill") adult workforce preparation program.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in

1 Section 1 is to provide partial funding for Volunteers to be used  
2 for salaries, supplies, and occupancy costs to support the  
3 establishment of an office in the 32210 area providing healthcare,  
4 prescriptions and screenings. The appropriation will also provide  
5 funding to Goodwill to fund the establishment of an adult workforce  
6 preparation program in northwest Jacksonville. The appropriation is  
7 also providing funding for a public information campaign related to  
8 retention ponds.

9 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section  
10 1 of this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal  
11 year 2019-2020.

12 **Section 4. Invoking the exception to Sec. 126.107(g),**  
13 **Ordinance Code.** The City is hereby authorized to enter into an  
14 agreement with each of Volunteers in Medicine Jacksonville, Inc.  
15 and Goodwill Industries of North Florida, Inc., for each to provide  
16 the services as set forth in Section 2 above. Pursuant to Section  
17 126.107(g), *Ordinance Code*, such procurement is exempted from  
18 competitive solicitation. With the exception of the foregoing, all  
19 other provisions of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code* shall remain in  
20 full force and effect.

21 **Section 5. Approval and Authorization.** There is hereby  
22 approved, and the Mayor or his designee and Corporation Secretary  
23 are hereby authorized to execute and deliver: (i) a funding  
24 agreement, including amendments thereto, in accordance with Chapter  
25 118, Parts 1-5, *Ordinance Code*, with Volunteers in Medicine  
26 Jacksonville, Inc. ("Volunteer Agreement") to appropriate \$36,934  
27 to be used for salaries, supplies, and occupancy costs to support  
28 the establishment of an office in the 32210 area providing  
29 healthcare, prescriptions and screenings, as more fully described  
30 in **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev Volunteers  
31 Agmt, September 16, 2019 - NCSPHS" attached hereto; and (ii) a

1 funding agreement, in accordance with Chapter 118, Parts 1-5,  
2 Ordinance Code, with Goodwill Industries of North Florida, Inc.  
3 ("Goodwill Agreement") to appropriate \$36,933 to be used for the  
4 establishment of an adult workforce preparation program in  
5 northwest Jacksonville. Funding will be used for candidate  
6 assistance, full-time college navigator position, financial  
7 coaching, GED classes and workshops, occupancy, supplies, and  
8 travel as more fully described on **Revised Exhibit 3**, labeled as  
9 "Revised Exhibit 3, Rev Goodwill Agmt, September 16, 2019 - NCSPHS"  
10 attached hereto.

11 The Mayor or his designee, and Corporation Secretary, are also  
12 authorized to execute additional amendments to each of the  
13 Volunteer Agreement and Goodwill Agreement to amend the City's  
14 maximum indebtedness amount under each agreement in accordance with  
15 such amounts as appropriated by the Council to each agreement in  
16 the annual budget ordinance or separate appropriation ordinances.

17 **Section 6. Requesting one cycle emergency passage**  
18 **pursuant to Council Rules 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency  
19 passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the  
20 emergency is that the appropriations and funding agreements will be  
21 effective within fiscal year 2018/19 and these funds will otherwise  
22 lapse to the General Fund/General Services District Fund balance as  
23 of September 30, 2019.

24 **Section 7. Oversight.** The Office of Grants and  
25 Compliance shall oversee the two funding agreements described  
26 herein.

27 **Section 8. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
29 without the Mayor's signature.
