> The funding above is a transfer from General Fund -Various to General Fund - Cure Violence to contractual services and subsidies and contributions to private organizations to continue funding for the Cure Violence program through fiscal year 2019-2020.

Carryover. The funds appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal year 2019-2020.

Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 3. Section 1 is to provide additional funds for ongoing Cure Violence Program implementation and for training and technical assistance, site operations, social services, data analytics and activities necessary for continued implementation of the Cure Violence public health model violence reduction strategy.

Approval and authorization to execute. Section 4. Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute agreements, including amendments thereto, subject to the terms, scope and conditions more fully described in Exhibit 2 attached hereto.

Section 5. Expenditure of Public Funds on Food, pursuant to 106.203(b), Ordinance Code. The Cure Violence program is authorized to expend funds (up to 5% of the total grant in the aggregate) on food and beverage. The purpose of the Cure Violence grant is outreach to the community to effectuate change with the goal of reducing violence. The food will be one source of interacting with the community at large to implement the Cure Violence program.
