Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's reappointment of Brenna M. Durden as a member of the Downtown Development Review Board, as a full-time employee at a business located within the downtown area representative, for a first full term ending June 30, 2021.

Background Information: The Downtown Development Review Board is established pursuant to Section 656.361.7, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to review and make decisions with respect to all applications for development and redevelopment within the Downtown Overlay Zone. The nine voting members of the board are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, in various categories including a contractor, developer or realtor who does work within the downtown area.

Ms. Durden has a Juris Doctor from the University of Florida College of Law. She practices governmental, land use, environmental and administrative law at Lewis, Longman and Walker. She resides within Council District #7.
