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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

  Intersection IMP, Brge-Bridges to San Clerc Road

Pedestrian Bridges for the design and construction of two pedestrian bridges and handrailing. This is reappropriation of existing dollars. Once the project is completed, unspent dollars shall any revert to 143/PWCP143RD549/06505/PW0381-02.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 above is to fund the design and construction of two predestrian bridges and handrailing. The existing wooden pedestrian bridges are impassable and unsafe. This pedestrian project will replace the bridge deck structure while leaving the existing pilings.

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CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2019-505-E, being Section 3. the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reduce funding for the project entitled "Countywide intersection IMP, Brge-Bridges" and provide funding for the project entitled "San Clerc Road Pedestrian Bridges." The projects are more fully described in the Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in the delay of replacing crtical unnecessary transporation infrastructure. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of twothirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become
