Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Council President's appointment of Monty Selim, to the Renew Arlington Community Redevelopment Agency Advisory Board, as a Planning Field Representative, filling a seat formerly held by Steven A. Berry, for a partial term ending December 31, 2019, followed by a first full term ending December 31, 2023.

Background Information: The Renew Arlington Community Redevelopment Agency Advisory Board was established by Ordinance 2015-738-E, and charged to review and make recommendations to the Council on proposed changes to the CRA Plan or amendments thereto; all proposed road closures and rezoning of properties located within the CRA boundary; and plans and programs developed by the Office of Economic Development regarding the CRA Plan. Section 53.102, *Ordinance Code*, provides that four of the seven members of the board are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council, in various categories, including a public policy / economic development profession representative, that is not a registered lobbyist.

Mr. Selim received a bachelor's degree in civil engineering from Cairo University, Egypt and is President of *Selim Consulting*, *Inc*. Mr. Selim resides in the Mandarin area within Council District #6.
