13 the Safety and Crime Reduction Commission; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the City Council shall appoint twenty members of the  
15 Safety and Crime Reduction Commission as provided by Section  
16 78.103, *Ordinance Code*; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Council Member Samuel Newby, at the request of the  
18 Council President at a publicly noticed meeting held on Thursday,  
19 August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019, has interviewed and vetted all candidates for  
20 appointments to the Safety and Crime Reduction Commission; now  
21 therefore

22 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appointment.** The Council hereby confirms the  
24 appointment of Shelley Grant, a Duval County resident, to the  
25 Safety and Crime Reduction Commission, in accordance with Section  
26 78.103, *Ordinance Code*, for an initial term expiring June 30, 2021.

27 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become  
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
29 without the Mayor's signature.
