AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND SOUTH ORTEGA LAND TRUST FOR 8,300 SQUARE FEET OF OFFICE SPACE AΤ 6331 ROOSEVELT BOULEVARD FOR A TERM OF 10 YEARS AND 10 MONTHS MONTHS) WITH TWO FIVE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE REAL ESTATE DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; APPROPRIATING \$212,655.00 FROM THE TAX COLLECTOR'S FUND BALANCE TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR FURNITURE, FIXTURES, AND EQUIPMENT, INFRASTRUCTURE TECHNOLOGY AND OTHER EXPENSES RELATING TO THE RELOCATION OF THETAX COLLECTOR'S CEDAR HILLS BRANCH TO 6331 ROOSEVELT BOULEVARD AS WELL AS FUNDING FOR MAIL EQUIPMENT, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 19-093; PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS TO SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEARS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2018-2019 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the accounts listed in subsection (b):

The funding above is a transfer of funds from the Tax Collector Fund Balance to provide funds for furniture, fixtures and equipment, infrastructure technology and other expenses relating to the relocation of the Tax Collector's Cedar Hills branch to 6331 Roosevelt Boulevard as well as funding for mail equipment.

Section 2. Carryover. The funds appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into subsequent fiscal years.

Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide additional funds for furniture, fixtures, and equipment, infrastructure technology and other expenses related to the relocation of the Tax Collector's Cedar Hills branch to 6331 Roosevelt Boulevard as well as funding for mail equipment.

Section 4. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are authorized to execute and deliver, that certain Lease Agreement between the City and South Ortega Land Trust, a copy of which has been placed ON FILE with the Office of Legislative Services. Said lease is for 8,300 square feet of office space at 6331 Roosevelt Boulevard for a term of 10 years and 10 months (130 months) with two five-year renewal options.

Section 5. Oversight. The Real Estate Division of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the project described herein.
