PURPOSE: White Paper (Explain Why this legislation is necessary? Provide; Who, What, When, Where, How and the Impact.) Council Research will complete this form for Council introduced legislation and the Administration is responsible for all other legislation. (Minimum of 350 words - Maximum of 1 page.)

This legislation is necessary for City Council to authorize the Mayor to execute the Assignment and Assumption of the Stipulation of Parties between the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida East Cost Railway, L.L.C. (Railway) and The City of Jacksonville. The City has filed an application with FDOT to offset the expansion of the Nira Street railroad-highway public at grade crossing, to permanently close two railroad-highway public at grade crossings. The first closure location is Gary Street and second closure location is Naldo Avenue, pursuant to Chapter 335.141(1), Florida Statutes and Rule 14-57.012, Florida Administrative Code. The City also agrees to enter into a separate agreement with the Railway to pay an annual license fee and maintenance fee of the crossing surface, including all track bed and rail components, the highway roadbed, for the width of the rail ties within the crossing area at Nira Street railroad-highway public at grade crossing.

In the Stipulation of Parties, the City agrees to the conditions stated which includes: The railroad, at the city's expense, will provide all necessary materials to install a pedestrian grade crossing surface on the north side of the Nira Street Crossing (Exhibit 'C'), in compliance with the Railroad Crossing Design Standard 222.2.4 (Exhibit 'D'); the Railroad, at the City's expense, will provide or furnish all necessary materials and install the automated railroad grade crossing warning device to include Type III, Class IV flashing lights and gates, in accordance with the Department's Standards Plans Index 509-070 (Exhibit 'E'). The City also agrees, at the City's expense, to remove all evidence of the crossing, restore the Railway's right-of-way, and provide permanent closure signs and object markers as identified in FDOT's Standard Plan, Index 700-109.
