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## **ORDINANCE 2019-383**

MAYOR ΑN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A STIPULATION AGREEMENT AMONG THE CITY JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA EAST COAST RAILWAY, LLC, AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) PROVIDING FOR PERMANENT CLOSING OF A RAILROAD-HIGHWAY PUBLIC GRADE CROSSING ATGARY STREET RAILROAD-HIGHWAY PUBLIC AT GRADE CROSSING AT NALDO AVENUE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Authorization. The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver a Stipulation Agreement among the City of Jacksonville, Florida East Coast Railway, LLC, and the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), in substantially the placed ON FILE with the Office of Legislative Services. The City has filed an application with FDOT to offset the expansion of the Nira Street railroad-highway public at grade crossing to close permanently a railroad-highway public at grade crossing at Gary Street and a railroad-highway public at grade crossing at Naldo Avenue. The City assumes the cost of providing all necessary materials to install a pedestrian grade crossing surface and the automated railroad grade crossing warning device on the north side of the Nira Street crossing. The City also assumes the cost of removing all evidence of the crossing at Naldo Avenue, restoring

the Railway's right-of-way, and providing permanent closure signs 1 2 and object markers. The City will also enter into a separate agreement with the Railway to pay an annual license fee and 3 maintenance fee for the crossing surface, including all track bed 4 and rail components and the highway roadbed for the width of the 5 rail ties within the crossing area at Nira Street railroad-highway 6
