These funds must be

committed to eligible projects no later than June 30,

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2021, and be fully expended for completed projects no later than June 30, 2022.

Purpose. The Florida Housing Section 2. Finance Corporation provides funds to local governments as an incentive to create partnerships that produce and preserve affordable homeownership and multifamily housing. The program was designed to serve very low, low, and moderate income families. SHIP dollars may be used for emergency repairs, new construction, rehabilitation, down payment and closing costs assistance, impact construction and gap financing, mortgage buy-downs, acquisition of property for affordable housing, matching dollars for federal housing grants and programs, and homeownership counseling. A copy of the Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing the proposed use of funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the 2019-2020 SHIP Estimate is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the certified minutes excerpt of the March 27, 2019 regular meeting of the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission is attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Approval of Positions. There are hereby approved the positions more fully described in R.C. 19-153, attached hereto as Exhibit 5 and incorporated herein by this reference.
