Section 2. Purpose. The Florida Housing Finance Corporation provides funds to local governments as an incentive to create partnerships that produce and preserve affordable homeownership and multifamily housing. The program was designed to serve very low, low, and moderate income families. SHIP dollars may be used for emergency repairs, new construction, rehabilitation, and closing costs assistance, impact down payment construction and gap financing, mortgage buy-downs, acquisition of property for affordable housing, matching dollars for federal housing grants and programs, and homeownership counseling. A copy of the Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing the proposed use of funds is attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised Schedule, June 17, 2019 - NCSPHS" incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the certified minutes excerpt of the March 27, 2019 regular meeting of the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and incorporated herein by this reference.
