(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above in the amount of \$536,560.00 comprises annual Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to be administered pursuant to 24 CFR 576.100(c).

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding to: i) engage homeless individuals and families living on the street; ii) improve the number and quality of emergency shelters for homeless individuals families; iii) help operate the shelters; iv) provide essential services to shelter residents; v) rapidly re-house homeless individuals and families; and, vi) prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless. The Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing the proposed use of funds is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the grant award letter is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the certified minutes excerpt of the March 27, 2019 regular meeting of the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission is attached hereto as Exhibit 4 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
