WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development awards to local governments Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Program funds, and the local government may further award the CDBG funds to recipient organizations to implement the CDBG program; and

29 WHEREAS, the purpose of CDBG is to provide activities that 30 develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a 31 suitable living environment, and by expanding economic opportunities, principally for low and moderate income persons; and

2 WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville is expected to receive 3 \$6,289,951.00 in CDBG funds from the United States Department of 4 Housing and Urban Development on or about October 1, 2019, and 5 these moneys require appropriation; and

6 WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville has \$1,121,358.00 in CDBG
7 program income and \$1,150,000.00 in reprogrammed funds and these
8 moneys require appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development 9 Commission (the "Commission") has been designated as the agency to 10 11 provide oversight and guidance to the City of Jacksonville's 12 Neighborhoods Department, Housing and Community Development Division, and the Commission shall make recommendations on all 13 14 agreements for community development and affordable housing and related programs entered into for and on behalf of the City as set 15 forth in Section 34.203, Ordinance Code; and 16

WHEREAS, the Commission has engaged in its 2019-2020 Universal 17 Cycle application process and awarded contract(s) to housing 18 providers and for community development pending receipt 19 and 20 appropriation of the 2019-2020 CDBG funds from the United States 21 Department of Housing and Urban Development, according to the 22 action taken by the Commission as set forth in the certified minutes excerpt of its March 27, 2019 regular meeting, attached 23 hereto as **Exhibit 1**, for the appropriations and authorizations 24 25 relating to affordable housing and community development requested 26 herein; and

WHEREAS, these recommended awards for affordable housing and community development requested herein are as set forth in B.T. 20-004, attached hereto as Exhibit 2, and made a part hereof; now, therefore,

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

2 Section 1. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated 3 the sum of \$8,561,309.000 to the City of Jacksonville for award of CDBG Program funds made pursuant to the Commission's 2019-2020 4 Universal Cycle relating to affordable housing and community 5 development, and to other City departments as appropriate for the 6 7 remaining awards, and the City of Jacksonville is authorized to enter into federal program contracts as appropriate and expend 8 9 those funds in accordance with awards identified in B.T. 20-004. 10 The sum of \$8,561,309.00 is hereby appropriated from the indicated sums in the accounts listed in subsection (a) to the accounts 11 listed in subsection (b) of B.T. 20-004, attached hereto and made 12 a part hereof: 13

(c) Explanation of Appropriation.

The funding above is federal income received from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (\$6,289,951.00 in CDBG program funding, \$1,21,358.00 in program income, and \$1,150,000.00 in reprogrammed funds).

23 Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation set Section 2. forth in Section 1 above is to expend the 2019-2020 available 24 25 federal income received from the United States Department of 26 Housing and Urban Development, and award the federal contracts (as 27 appropriate) for the CDBG program and funding to organizations and the amounts, all as set forth in B.T. 20-004. A copy of the 28 Schedule of Proposed Funding is attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and 29 30 incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the grant award letter is attached hereto as Exhibit 4. 31

1 Section 3. Further Council Action. If the United States 2 Department of Housing and Urban Development approves a different 3 allocation of funds than is appropriated by this ordinance, then 4 the Mayor shall submit a supplementary budget to City Council for 5 approval in accordance with the actual allocation received.

6 Section 4. Execution of Documents. The Mayor, or his 7 designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to 8 execute and deliver any and all documents necessary to effectuate 9 the purpose set forth in Section 2 above.

Section 5. Authorization of Positions. There are hereby authorized the positions more fully described in R.C. 20-003, attached hereto as Exhibit 5 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
