AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING A CONTINUATION GRANT; PROVIDING FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM; APPROPRIATING \$8,561,309.00 (\$6,289,951.00 IN CDBG PROGRAM FUNDING, \$1,121,358.00 IN PROGRAM \$1,150,000.00 INCOME, AND IN REPROGRAMMED FUNDS) FOR PROGRAM COSTS, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 20-004; PROVIDING FOR THE AWARD, AUTHORIZATION, AND FUNDING, AND FOR THE CITY JACKSONVILLE TO EXECUTE FEDERAL PROGRAM CONTRACTS FOR CDBG PROGRAM FUNDS, APPLICABLE, TO IMPLEMENT REVISED B.T. 20-004; PROVIDING FOR PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR FURTHER COUNCIL ACTION IF REVENUE DIFFERS; PROVIDING FOR THE MAYOR AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER DOCUMENTS RELATING TO THE AWARDS; APPROVING POSITIONS, AS INITIATED BY R.C. 20-003; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development awards to local governments Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Program funds, and the local government may further award the CDBG funds to recipient organizations to implement the CDBG program; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of CDBG is to provide activities that develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment, and by expanding economic opportunities, principally for low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville is expected to receive \$6,289,951.00 in CDBG funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development on or about October 1, 2019, and these moneys require appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville has \$1,121,358.00 in CDBG program income and \$1,150,000.00 in reprogrammed funds and these moneys require appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission (the "Commission") has been designated as the agency to provide oversight and guidance to the City of Jacksonville's Neighborhoods Department, Housing and Community Development Division, and the Commission shall make recommendations on all agreements for community development and affordable housing and related programs entered into for and on behalf of the City as set forth in Section 34.203, Ordinance Code; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has engaged in its 2019-2020 Universal Cycle application process and awarded contract(s) to housing providers and for community development pending receipt and appropriation of the 2019-2020 CDBG funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, according to the action taken by the Commission as set forth in the certified minutes excerpt of its March 27, 2019 regular meeting, attached hereto as Exhibit 1, for the appropriations and authorizations relating to affordable housing and community development requested herein; and

WHEREAS, these recommended awards for affordable housing and community development requested herein are as set forth in Revised

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30 31 B.T. 20-004, attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised B.T. 20-004, June 17, 2019 - NCSPHS", and made a part hereof; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. **Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$8,561,309.00 to the City of Jacksonville for award of CDBG Program funds made pursuant to the Commission's 2019-2020 Universal Cycle relating to affordable housing and community development, and to other City departments as appropriate for the remaining awards, and the City of Jacksonville is authorized to enter into federal program contracts as appropriate and expend those funds in accordance with awards identified in Revised B.T. The sum of \$8,561,309.00 is hereby appropriated from the indicated sums in the accounts listed in subsection (a) to the accounts listed in subsection (b) of Revised B.T. 20-004, attached hereto and made a part hereof:

- (C) Explanation of Appropriation.

The funding above is federal income received from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (\$6,289,951.00 in CDBG program funding, \$1,121,358.00 in program income, and \$1,150,000.00 in reprogrammed funds).

Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation set Section 2. forth in Section 1 above is to expend the 2019-2020 available federal income received from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, and award the federal contracts (as appropriate) for the CDBG program and funding to organizations and

the amounts, all as set forth in Revised B.T. 20-004. A copy of the Schedule of Proposed Funding is attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit** 3, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Revised Schedule, June 17, 2019 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the grant award letter is attached hereto as **Exhibit 4**.

Section 3. Further Council Action. If the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development approves a different allocation of funds than is appropriated by this ordinance, then the Mayor shall submit a supplementary budget to City Council for approval in accordance with the actual allocation received.

Section 4. Execution of Documents. The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver any and all documents necessary to effectuate the purpose set forth in Section 2 above.

Section 5. Authorization of Positions. There are hereby authorized the positions more fully described in R.C. 20-003, attached hereto as **Exhibit 5** and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
