12 LOW-INCOME PERSONS LIVING WITH HIV/AIDS AND
13 THEIR FAMILIES WITHIN DUVAL COUNTY, AS

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
20 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the
21 indicated sum from the account listed in subsection (a) to the
22 account listed in subsection (b):

29 (c) Explanation of Appropriation.

30 The funding above in the amount of \$2,634,349.00 consists
31 of an annual Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS

(HOPWA) grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide a wide range of housing, social services, program planning, and development costs, including but not limited to: the acquisition, rehabilitation, or new construction of housing units; costs for facility operations; rental assistance; and, short term payments to prevent homelessness. An essential component in providing housing assistance for this targeted special needs population is the coordination and delivery of support services. Consequently, HOPWA funds also may be used for services, including but not limited to: assessment and case management; substance abuse treatment; mental health treatment; nutritional services; job training and placement assistance; and, assistance with daily living. The Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing the proposed use of funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**. A copy of the grant award letter is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the certified minutes excerpt of the March 27, 2019 regular meeting of the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission is attached hereto as **Exhibit 4** and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Approval of Position. There is hereby approved the position more fully described in R.C. 20-001, attached hereto as **Exhibit 5** and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
