An essential component in 8 9 providing housing assistance for this targeted special needs 10 population is the coordination and delivery of support services. Consequently, HOPWA funds also may be used for services, including 11 but not limited to: assessment and case management; substance abuse 12 treatment; mental health treatment; nutritional services; 13 job training and placement assistance; and, assistance with daily 14 living. 22 Section 3. Approval of Position. There is hereby 23 approved the position more fully described in R.C. 20-001, attached 24 hereto as Exhibit 5 and incorporated herein by this reference.

25 Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become 26 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 27 without the Mayor's signature.
