6 APPROPRIATING \$2,634,349.00 IN ANNUAL HOUSING  
7 OPPORTUNITY FOR PERSONS WITH AIDS (HOPWA)  
8 PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT  
9 OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT TO PROVIDE A  
10 WIDE RANGE OF HOUSING, SOCIAL SERVICES,  
11 PROGRAM PLANNING, AND DEVELOPMENT COSTS TO  
12 LOW-INCOME PERSONS LIVING WITH HIV/AIDS AND  
13 THEIR FAMILIES WITHIN DUVAL COUNTY, AS  
14 INITIATED BY B.T. 20-005; APPROVING POSITION,  
15 AS INITIATED BY R.C. 20-001; PROVIDING FOR AN  
16 EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
20 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the  
21 indicated sum from the account listed in subsection (a) to the  
22 account listed in subsection (b):

29 (c) Explanation of Appropriation.

30 The funding above in the amount of \$2,634,349.00 consists  
31 of an annual Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS

1 (HOPWA) grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and  
2 Urban Development.

3 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
4 Section 1 is to provide a wide range of housing, social services,  
5 program planning, and development costs, including but not limited  
6 to: the acquisition, rehabilitation, or new construction of housing  
7 units; costs for facility operations; rental assistance; and, short  
8 term payments to prevent homelessness. An essential component in  
9 providing housing assistance for this targeted special needs  
10 population is the coordination and delivery of support services.  
11 Consequently, HOPWA funds also may be used for services, including  
12 but not limited to: assessment and case management; substance abuse  
13 treatment; mental health treatment; nutritional services; job  
14 training and placement assistance; and, assistance with daily  
15 living. The Schedule of Proposed Funding detailing the proposed use  
16 of funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**. A copy of the grant award  
17 letter is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and incorporated herein by  
18 this reference. A copy of the certified minutes excerpt of the  
19 March 27, 2019 regular meeting of the Jacksonville Housing and  
20 Community Development Commission is attached hereto as **Exhibit 4**  
21 and incorporated herein by this reference.

22 **Section 3. Approval of Position.** There is hereby  
23 approved the position more fully described in R.C. 20-001, attached  
24 hereto as **Exhibit 5** and incorporated herein by this reference.

25 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
26 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
27 without the Mayor's signature.
