## **ORDINANCE 2019-398**

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY; WAIVING THE REVERTER PROVISION OF ORDINANCE 2018-39-E TO ALLOW PREVIOUS SURPLUSSED VEHICLE (2010 CHEVROLET IMPALA, VIN 2G1WA5EK8A1200413, VEHICLE NUMBER 8369-20) TO BE DISPOSED OF BY THE TOWN OF BALDWIN; DECLARING THAT CERTAIN 2008 CHEVROLET IMPALA (VIN 2GIWB58K389286198, VEHICLE NUMBER 1948-30) VALUED AT \$5,100 TO BE SURPLUS TO THE CITY AND NEEDS OF THE AUTHORIZING THEAPPROPRIATE OFFICIALS OF THE CITY TO TRANSFER TITLE OF SAID PROPERTY TO THE TOWN OF BALDWIN FOR ITS USE, AT NO COST, IN ACCORDANCE WITH 122.812(C), ORDINANCE SECTION CODE; DESIGNATING THE FLEET MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT TO MONITOR ACTUAL USE OF SAID PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR A REVERTER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council in Ordinance 2018-39-E donated 4 vehicles to the Town of Baldwin, with a reverter provision that a vehicle be returned to the City of Jacksonville in the event that the vehicle is not used for the purposed contemplated in the legislation; and

WHEREAS, one of the vehicles, the 2010 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2G1WA5EK8A1200413, Vehicle Number 8369-20) valued at \$4,475, has a blown engine and is inoperable; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville Fleet Management Division has inspected the vehicle and is of the opinion that the cost to retrieve and retitle the vehicle will exceed the anticipated revenues for that condition vehicle at auction; and

WHEREAS, for this reason, a waiver is desired to allow the Town of Baldwin to dispose of the vehicle and for the City of Jacksonville to donate a replacement vehicle; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Waiver of Reverter Clause in Ordinance 2018-Section 1. 39-E for 2010 Chevrolet impala (VIN 2G1WA5EK8A1200413, Vehicle Number 8369-20). Ordinance 2018-39-E found a valid public purpose to donate surplussed vehicles to the Town of Baldwin for municipal use for the town of Baldwin. The disposition authorized was conditioned upon the Town of Baldwin's using the said vehicles for the purposes set forth therein and was conditioned upon the Town of Baldwin's agreeing to convey the vehicles back to the City of Jacksonville in the event that the vehicles were not used for those purposes. One of the vehicles, a 2010 Chevrolet impala (VIN 2G1WA5EK8A1200413, Vehicle Number 8369-20) valued at \$4,475, has a blown engine and is inoperable. The City of Jacksonville Fleet Management Division has inspected the vehicle and evaluated the cost to retrieve and retitle the vehicle. The Fleet Management Division has estimated the revenue that would be generated by the sale of such vehicle and believes that the expenses would exceed the revenues, and for this reason recommends a waiver of the reverter be enacted by Council. The Council hereby waives the reverter provision of 2018-39-E, as to the 2010 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2G1WA5EK8A1200413, Vehicle Number 8369-20), to allow for the Town of Baldwin to dispose of the vehicle.

Section 2. Declaration of Surplus. The City hereby declares that certain 2008 Chevrolet Impala (VIN 2GIWB58K389286198,

vehicle number 1948-30) valued at \$5,100, as more particularly described in **Exhibit 1** attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference ("Subject Property"), to be surplus to the needs of the City of Jacksonville and authorizes the appropriate City officials to transfer title of the Subject Property to the Town of Baldwin at no cost, pursuant to Section 122.812(c), Ordinance Code. A copy of the certificate from the Director of Procurement certifying compliance with provisions of Chapter 122, Ordinance Code, is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**, and incorporated herein by this reference. A copy of the property transfer form is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**.

Section 3. Public Purpose. The surplus vehicle is needed by the Town of Baldwin for municipal use. The City of Jacksonville finds that providing the surplussed vehicle to the Town of Baldwin is a valid public purpose.

Section 4. Fleet Management Division to Monitor Actual Use of Subject Property. The Fleet Management Division of the Finance and Administration Department will be the designated agency to monitor the Town of Baldwin's use of the Subject Property in accordance with the purposes set forth herein.

Section 5. Reverter. The disposition authorized herein is conditioned upon the Town of Baldwin using the said vehicle for the purposes set forth herein and is conditioned upon the Town of Baldwin agreeing to convey the vehicle back to the City of Jacksonville in the event that the vehicle is not used for those purposes.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
