Type of Action: Waiving reverter provision

Bill Summary: This bill waives the reverter provision of Ordinance 2018-39-E to allow previous surplus vehicle valued at \$5,100 to be surplus to the needs of the City; authorizes the appropriate officials of the City to transfer title of said property to the town of Baldwin for its use, at no cost, in accordance with Section 122.812(C), *Ordinance Code*; designates the Fleet Management Division of the Finance and Administration Department to monitor actual use of said property; and provides for a reverter.

Background Information: The City donated four vehicles to the Town of Baldwin with a reverter provision. The 2010 Chevrolet Impala, VIN #2G1WA5EK8A1200413, Vehicle Number 8369-20 is no longer operable for the designated purpose. Fleet Management has determined that the cost to repair the vehicle far exceeds its value. Thus, the waiver is requested to declare a 2008 Chevrolet Impala, VIN #2GIWB58K389286198, Vehicle Number 1948-30 surplus as a replacement for the Town of Baldwin.
