traffic calming study Section 2. Purpose. A conducted to assess the need for speed reducing mechanisms and identify and recommend speed table spacing in the Southside Estates neighborhood. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 above is to allow speed tables to be placed on Live Oak Drive, Peach Drive, and Forest Boulevard in the Southside Estates area. Based on the corridors and suggested spacing, the lengths of Drive/Live Oak Drive between Beach Boulevard and Atlantic Boulevard is estimated to need 22 speed tables and Forest Boulevard between Beach Boulevard and Peach Drive is estimated to need 13 speed tables.

Section 3. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2019-505-E, being the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reduce funding for the project entitled "Traffic Calming Construction" and provide funding for the project entitled "Southside Estates Traffic Calming." The projects are more fully described in the Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in the unnecessary delay of the installation of the needed speed tables. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.
