(c) Explanation of Appropriation

Ordinance 2018-195-E appropriated \$3,000,000.00 from the Northwest Jacksonville Economic Development Fund and set it aside to specifically address Food Desert related matters within Northwest Jacksonville. Ordinance 2019-245-E required the Office of Economic Development ("OED") to submit legislation outlining the criteria for the Pilot Programs and a proposed allocation of funds related thereto, prior to appropriating funding. The appropriation authorizes funding for two pilot programs.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for the Mobile Market Program in the amount of \$200,000, and the Expanded Inventory Offering Program in the amount of \$100,000.

Allocation of Funds for the Food Desert Pilot Programs. There is hereby approved and adopted the food desert pilot programs, consisting of the Delivery Initiatives Program, the Mobile Market Program, the Transportation Program, and the Expanded Inventory Offering Program. A description of the objective, proposed allocation of funds, and criteria for each pilot program is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.
