ORDINANCE CONCERNING EMERGENCY 5 AN MEDICAL 6 TRANSPORTATION SERVICES; MAKING FINDINGS; 7 DECLARING THAT PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND 8 NECESSITY REQUIRE THE TRANSFER OR ASSIGNMENT 9 OF CERTIFICATE FOR EMERGENCY Α MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION 10 SERVICES FROM AMBULANCE SERVICE, INC. TO AMERIPRO EMS OF FLORIDA, LLC; 11 AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE FIRE 12 AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, OR DESIGNEE, TO TRANSFER OR 13 ASSIGN SAID CERTIFICATE; PROVIDING CONDITIONS 14 FOR RECERTIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONTINUED 15 OPERATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 16

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: Section 1. Findings. The Council finds that:

(a) Ambulance Service, Inc. ("ASI") has been a private ambulance provider in Jacksonville (Duval County) for over fifty years and currently provides emergency medical transportation services through a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (COPCN) issued by the City of Jacksonville, Certificate Number 99-316-A.

(b) Certificate 99-316-A is one of the six current COPCNs in
Duval County for emergency medical transportation services.

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(c) Certificate 99-316-A will expire on June 22, 2020.

30 (d) The original owner of ASI has decided to retire, and as a31 result ASI is in the process of being purchased by another private

1 ambulance service provider, AmeriPro EMS of Florida, LLC
2 ("AmeriPro").

3 (e) ASI wishes to transfer Certificate Number 99-316-A to
4 AmeriPro to allow the continuation of emergency medical
5 transportation services to the residents of Jacksonville.

(d) Section 158.214, Ordinance Code, provides that no COPCN
"shall be assignable or transferable by the holder of the
certificate except on approval by the [City] Council."

9 (d) The recertification application for the Certificate of 10 Public Convenience and Necessity Number 99-316-A in the name of 11 AmeriPro EMS of Florida, LLC will be filed with the City by 12 AmeriPro.

(e) The City of Jacksonville will make a full and thorough review of the filing of Certificate Number 99-316-A following the recertification application pursuant to Chapter 158, Ordinance Code.

(f) Continued operation of the emergency medical transportation services after the expiration of the current Certificate is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Jacksonville.

(g) The continuation of services and continuity of operations is facilitated by transfer of the Certificate to a private ambulance service provider with whom the regulatory agencies of the City of Jacksonville are familiar.

(h) The City will review all information necessary to confirm
or deny the qualifications of AmeriPro to operate the emergency
medical transportation services in the form of a complete and total
application, pursuant to Chapter 158, Ordinance Code, prior to the
expiration of Certificate Number 99-316-A on June 22, 2020.

30 (i) The immediate transfer of Certificate Number 99-316-A to
 31 AmeriPro is necessary to allow the transition of the ASI emergency

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1 medical transportation services to AmeriPro and to provide 2 uninterrupted service to the community.

3 (j) Continued operation of the emergency medical 4 transportation services by ASI from the date of transfer of 5 Certificate Number 99-316-A until the service is fully transitioned 6 to AmeriPro is in the best interests of the residents of the City.

7 Section 2. Transfer of Certificate. The public 8 convenience and necessity require the transfer or assignment of 9 ASI's Certificate Number 99-316-A to AmeriPro to operate the 10 vehicle(s) listed in its application for emergency medical transportation services. The Director of the Jacksonville Fire and 11 Rescue Department (JFRD), or his designee, is hereby authorized to 12 transfer or assign Certificate 99-316-A from ASI to AmeriPro. 13

14 Section 4. Continued Operation. In order to effect a 15 transition of the ASI emergency medical transportation services to 16 AmeriPro without interruption to the community, ASI is authorized 17 by the Council to continue providing the emergency medical 18 transportation services under its previous Certificate Number 99-19 316-A until the transition to AmeriPro is complete.

20 Section 5. Memorandum of Understanding. As a condition 21 of the transfer of the COPCN, AmeriPro will sign a Memorandum of 22 Understanding, as authorized by Section 158.307, Ordinance Code, 23 with the City under which AmeriPro agrees to divert its resources, 24 as requested by JFRD, in the event of an official declaration of 25 emergency by the Mayor during natural and other disasters to assist 26 in meeting the imminent needs of citizens of and visitors to the 27 City. In addition, AmeriPro agrees to participate in major sporting 28 events as requested by JFRD. The Mayor, or his designee, and the 29 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute the 30 Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Jacksonville and 31 AmeriPro EMS of Florida, LLC for Assistance for Special Events and

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1	Declared Emergencies, attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated
2	herein by this reference.
3	Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become
4	effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
5	without the Mayor's signature.
