- (2) On page 1, line 21, strike "Duval County" and insert "Nassau County";
- (3) On page 1, line 25½, <u>insert</u> a new Section 2 to read as follows:
  - "Section 2. A Non-Resident of Duval County with substantial economic business interests in Duval County.

    Section 50.102 (Members of boards and commissions),

    Ordinance Code, requires Board and Commission members be either a Duval County resident or individuals with substantial economic business interests or substantial philanthropic interests in Duval County. Dr. Pomm has substantial business interests in Duval County. Dr. Pomm has over 35 years in substance abuse and addiction services experience, and has been practicing in Duval County for 22 years. Dr. Pomm also has several notable presentations regarding substance abuse and addiction.";
- (4) Renumber remaining Sections accordingly;
- (5) On **page 1**, **line 1**, amend the introductory sentence to add that the bill was amended as reflected herein.
