WHEREAS, Ordinance 2019-56-E enacted March 26, 2019, created the Opioid Abuse Prevention Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor shall appoint nine members of the Opioid Abuse Prevention Committee within various categories as provided by Section 84.202, Ordinance Code; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appointment. The Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Dr. Raymond M. Pomm, a Nassau County resident, to the Opioid Abuse Prevention Committee, as a Medical Professional, Program Treatment representative, in accordance with Section 84.202, Ordinance Code, for an initial term expiring September 30, 2022.

Section 2. Α Non-Resident of Duval County with substantial economic business interests in Duval County. Section 50.102 (Members of boards and commissions), Ordinance Code, requires Board and Commission members be either a Duval County resident or individuals with substantial economic business interests or substantial philanthropic interests in Duval County. Dr. Pomm has substantial business interests in Duval County. Dr. Pomm has over 35 years in substance abuse and addiction services experience, and has been practicing in Duval County for 22 years. Dr. Pomm also has several notable presentations regarding substance abuse and addiction.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
