7 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF DR.
8 RAYMOND M. POMM, AS A MEMBER OF THE OPIOID
9 ABUSE PREVENTION COMMITTEE, AS A MEDICAL
10 PROFESSIONAL, PROGRAM TREATMENT
11 REPRESENTATIVE, PURSUANT TO SECTION 84.202,
12 *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR AN INITIAL TERM ENDING
13 SEPTEMBER 30, 2022; ESTABLISHING SUBSTANTIAL
14 BUSINESS INTEREST IN DUVAL COUNTY, PURSUANT TO
15 SECTION 50.102(B) (RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT),
16 *ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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18 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2019-56-E enacted March 26, 2019, created
19 the Opioid Abuse Prevention Committee; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor shall appoint nine members of the Opioid
21 Abuse Prevention Committee within various categories as provided by
22 Section 84.202, *Ordinance Code*; now therefore

23 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

24 **Section 1. Appointment.** The Council hereby confirms the
25 Mayor's appointment of Dr. Raymond M. Pomm, a Nassau County
26 resident, to the Opioid Abuse Prevention Committee, as a Medical
27 Professional, Program Treatment representative, in accordance with
28 Section 84.202, *Ordinance Code*, for an initial term expiring
29 September 30, 2022.

1 **Section 2. A Non-Resident of Duval County with**
2 **substantial economic business interests in Duval County.** Section
3 50.102 (Members of boards and commissions), Ordinance Code,
4 requires Board and Commission members be either a Duval County
5 resident or individuals with substantial economic business
6 interests or substantial philanthropic interests in Duval County.
7 Dr. Pomm has substantial business interests in Duval County. Dr.
8 Pomm has over 35 years in substance abuse and addiction services
9 experience, and has been practicing in Duval County for 22 years.
10 Dr. Pomm also has several notable presentations regarding substance
11 abuse and addiction.

12 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become
13 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
14 without the Mayor's signature.
