AN ORDINANCE REZONING APPROXIMATELY 0.87± OF AN ACRE, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7 AT $265 ext{ } 44^{\text{TH}}$ STREET EAST, 281 44TH STREET EAST, 285 44TH STREET EAST AND 296 45TH STREET EAST, BETWEEN LIBERTY STREET AND SEBALD LANE (R.E. NOS. 031465-0000, 031467-0000, 031468-0000 AND 031511-0000), AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, OWNED BY UNITY MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH JACKSONVILLE FLORIDA, INC., FROM RESIDENTIAL LOW DENSITY-60 (RLD-60) DISTRICT TO PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) DISTRICT, AS DEFINED AND CLASSIFIED UNDER THE ZONING CODE, PERMIT INSTITUTIONAL USES, AS DESCRIBED IN THE UNITY MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH COMMUNITY RESIDENTIAL HOME PUD, PURSUANT TO FUTURE LAND USE MAP SERIES (FLUMS) SMALL-SCALE AMENDMENT APPLICATION NUMBER L-5377-19C; PROVIDING A DISCLAIMER THAT THE REZONING GRANTED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville adopted a Small-Scale Amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan for the purpose of revising portions of the Future Land Use Map series (FLUMs) in order to ensure the accuracy and internal consistency of the plan,

pursuant to application L-5377-19C and companion land use Ordinance 2019-631; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure consistency of zoning district with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan and the adopted companion Small-Scale Amendment L-5377-19C, an application to rezone and reclassify from Residential Low Density-60 (RLD-60) District to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District, was filed by Steve Diebenow, Esq., on behalf of Unity Missionary Baptist Church of Jacksonville Florida, Inc., the owner of approximately 0.87± of an acre of certain real property in Council District 7, as more particularly described in Section 1; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department, in order to ensure consistency of this zoning district with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, has considered the rezoning and has rendered an advisory opinion; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has considered the application and has rendered an advisory opinion; and

WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning (LUZ) Committee, after due notice, held a public hearing and made its recommendation to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council, after due notice, held a public hearing, and taking into consideration the above recommendations as well as all oral and written comments received during the public hearings, the Council finds that such rezoning is consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan adopted under the comprehensive planning ordinance for future development of the City of Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the proposed PUD does not affect adversely the orderly development of the City as embodied in the Zoning Code; will not affect adversely the health and safety of residents in the area; will not be detrimental to the natural environment or to the use or development of the adjacent properties

in the general neighborhood; and the proposed PUD will accomplish the objectives and meet the standards of Section 656.340 (Planned Unit Development) of the *Zoning Code* of the City of Jacksonville; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Subject Property Location and Description. The approximately 0.87± of an acre (R.E. Nos. 031465-0000, 031467-0000, 031468-0000 and 031511-0000) is located in Council District 7 at 265 44th Street East, 281 44th Street East, 285 44th Street East and 296 45th Street East, between Liberty Street and Sebald Lane, as more particularly described in the Legal Description dated April 3, 2019, and On File with the City Council Legislative Services Division (Subject Property).

Section 2. Owner and Applicant Description. The Subject Property is owned by Unity Missionary Baptist Church of Jacksonville Florida, Inc. and is described in the Legal Description On File. The agent is Steve Diebenow, Esq., One Independent Drive, Suite 1200, Jacksonville, Florida 32202; (904) 301-1269.

Section 3. Property Rezoned. The Subject Property, pursuant to adopted companion Small-Scale Amendment L-5377-19C, is hereby rezoned and reclassified from Residential Low Density-60 (RLD-60) District to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District. This new PUD district shall generally permit institutional uses, and is described, shown and subject to the following documents:

- **Revised On File** Revised Written Description dated September 18, 29 2019.
 - Revised On File Revised Site Plan dated September 26, 2019.
 - Section 4. Contingency. This rezoning shall not become

effective until 31 days after adoption of the companion Small-Scale Amendment unless challenged by the state land planning agency; and further provided that if the companion Small-Scale Amendment is challenged by the state land planning agency, this rezoning shall not become effective until the state land planning agency or the Administration Commission issues a final order determining the companion Small-Scale Amendment is in compliance with Chapter 163, Florida Statutes.

Section 5. Disclaimer. The rezoning granted herein shall not be construed as an exemption from any other applicable local, state, or federal laws, regulations, requirements, permits or approvals. All other applicable local, state or federal permits shall be obtained before commencement approvals development or use and issuance of this rezoning is based upon acknowledgement, representation and confirmation made applicant(s), owner(s), developer(s) and/or any authorized agent(s) or designee(s) that the subject business, development and/or use will be operated in strict compliance with all laws. Issuance of this rezoning does not approve, promote or condone any practice or act that is prohibited or restricted by any federal, state or local laws.

Section 6. Effective Date. The enactment of this Ordinance shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of the City Council and shall become effective upon signature by the Council President and the Council Secretary.
