ORDINANCE 2019-794

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2001-13-E, AS AMENDED, WHICH APPROVED A DEVELOPMENT ORDER FOR THE NOCATEE DEVELOPMENT OF REGIONAL IMPACT (DRI), INITIATED BY THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE TO PROVIDE FOR A FIRE STATION AT THE MOST EFFECTIVE LOCATION WITHIN THE DRI; FINDING THAT THESE CHANGES ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE 2030 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE'S LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, AND SECTION 380.06, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Council adopted and approved the Nocatee DRI Development Order by Ordinance 2001-13-E, and subsequently, has amended the Development Order by various Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville requests certain changes to the Nocatee DRI Development Order to provide for a fire station at the most effective location within the DRI; and

WHEREAS, the request has been reviewed by the City's Planning and Development Department; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department has submitted recommendations concerning the request; and

WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning Committee has reviewed the request, and made its recommendation to the Council; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was properly noticed and held by the Council pursuant to Section 380.06, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, after such public hearing and in consideration of the

recommendations made and submitted to the Council, the Council has made certain findings and determinations; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Development Order Amended. Section 28 of the Development Order for the Nocatee DRI is hereby amended as follows:

Section 28. Police and Fire Protection. Up to two (2) net developable acres shall be conveyed to the City of Jacksonville free and clear of liens and encumbrances at a mutually acceptable location within the Town Center Village to address impacts of the DRI for a fire station and/or a Jacksonville Sheriff's Office "stop" station. This site shall be donated to the City of Jacksonville after commencement of Phase III or thereafter. For this site, the Developer will either provide stormwater treatment through a centralized stormwater treatment system located off-site or will convey additional acreage upon which sufficiently sized stormwater treatment areas for the site may be located.

Section 2. Consistency. The Council hereby finds and determines that the changes and modifications set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance are consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, the City of Jacksonville's Land Development Regulations, and Section 380.06, Florida Statutes.

Section 3. Notice. The Legislative Services Division is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the following, immediately upon its effective date: Planning and Development Department, 214 North Hogan Street, Suite 300, Jacksonville, Florida 32202.

Section 4. Effective Date. The enactment of this Ordinance shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of the City Council and shall become effective upon signature by the Council President and the Council Secretary.
