AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE PURCHASE AND SALE AGREEMENT ("AGREEMENT") BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("BUYER") AND M & M INC. ("SELLER") AND ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO, AND OTHERWISE TAKE NECESSARY ACTION TO EFFECTUATE PURPOSES OF THE AGREEMENT, FOR THE ACQUISITION BY BUYER AT THE NEGOTIATED PURCHASE PRICE OF \$805,600.00 OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED ΙN COUNCIL DISTRICT 2 AT 12210 NEW BERLIN ROAD 106596-0000), COMPRISING (R.E.# AN APPROXIMATELY 10.52 ACRE PARCEL FOR THE LOCATION OF A NEW LIBRARY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC LIBRARY DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City, the Purchase and Sale Agreement between the City of Jacksonville (the "Buyer") and (the "Seller"), in substantially the form placed ON FILE with the Office of Legislative Services, and all such other documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance (with such "technical" changes as herein

authorized). The property at 12210 New Berlin Road (R.E.# 106596-0000), which is approximately 10.52 acres and which has been appraised at \$740,000.00, is being acquired for the location of a new library at a negotiated purchase price of \$805,600.00. The Purchase and Sale Agreement requires no deposit from the City, provides the City with a due diligence period through January 30, 2020, and allows the City to terminate the Purchase and Sale Agreement in its sole discretion without penalty during the due diligence period. Closing shall take place on February 13, 2020, or on a date mutually agreeable to both Buyer and Seller prior to February 13, 2020.

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and related documents may include The Agreement additions, deletions, and changes as may be reasonable, necessary, and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modification of the Agreement or related documents may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the Agreement or decrease the obligations or liability of the Seller, and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel. For purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City, including, but not limited to, changes in legal descriptions or surveys, ingress and egress, easements and rights of way, design standards, access and site plan, resolution of title defects, if any, and other nonsubstantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Agreement.

2	shall provide oversight and administration of the Agreement for the
3	duration thereof.
4	Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
5	effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
6	without the Mayor's signature.
