(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The appropriation above is from General Fund/General Services
District Fund Balance and is being appropriated to the Office
of Sports & Entertainment for furniture and equipment, and
professional services.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to facilitate setting up office spaces and equipment in the existing Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department (the "Department") location for the Sports and Entertainment Division (the "Division"). Pursuant to Ordinance 2019-395-E, the Sports and Entertainment Office was moved into the Department, creating a Sports and Entertainment division responsible for sports and entertainment activities within the City of Jacksonville, including but not limited to identifying sports and entertainment opportunities, benchmarking and assessment of opportunities, ensuring the development of a program design, relationship management, identification of funding mechanisms to support the events, and the tracking of value created through sports and entertainment opportunities. The Division will also be responsible for overseeing the Sports and Entertainment Trust Fund operating the Office of Special Events.

Section 3. Requesting one cycle emergency passage pursuant to Council Rules 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is the need to relocate the Sports and Entertainment Division so that it will be better able to assist with Department efficiency and outcomes.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
