AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN DUVAL COUNTY FIRST RESPONDER AGENCIES (THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE (JSO) AND THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT (JFRD)), AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 365.179, FLORIDA STATUTES, FACILITATE IN ORDER ΤO DIRECT RADIO COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN 9-1-1 PUBLIC SAFETY ANSWERING POINTS (PSAP) AND FIRST RESPONDERS; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY JSO; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 19 20 Section 1. Execution of Interlocal Agreement authorized. 21 The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are 22 hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the 23 City, the Interlocal Agreement between Duval County First Responder 24 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (JSO) Agencies (the and the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department (JFRD)), in substantially 25 26 the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein 27 by this reference (the "Agreement"), in compliance with Section 365.179, Florida Statutes. 28

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this legislation is
to authorize the execution of the Agreement. Section 365.179,
Florida Statutes, requires direct radio communications between 9-1-

1 Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP) and first responders. It 1 2 also requires the Sheriff to facilitate the development and execution of a written interlocal agreement between all primary 3 first responders within the county. The JSO PSAP and the JFRD PSAP 4 will provide notice by radio of a public safety emergency directly 5 to the on-duty personnel of the other referenced PSAP when the 6 7 other agency has not provided primary dispatch functions concerning 8 the agency.

9 Section 3. Oversight. Oversight shall be provided by 10 JSO.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
