NO. 044220-0000) OWNED BY 8 9 MOHAMMED N. MONA, AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, FROM PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) DISTRICT (1999-10 751-E) TO COMMERCIAL NEIGHBORHOOD 11 (CN) AND RESIDENTIAL MEDIUM DENSITY-A 12 (RMD-A) DISTRICTS, AS DEFINED AND CLASSIFIED UNDER THE 13 ZONING CODE, PURSUANT TO FUTURE LAND USE MAP 14 15 SERIES (FLUMS) LARGE-SCALE AMENDMENT APPLICATION NUMBER L-5381-19A; PROVIDING 16 A DISCLAIMER THAT THE REZONING GRANTED HEREIN 17 18 SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS AN EXEMPTION FROM 19 ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING AN 20 EFFECTIVE DATE.

22 WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville adopted a Large-Scale land 23 use amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan for the purpose of 24 revising portions of the Future Land Use Map series (FLUMs) in 25 order to ensure the accuracy and internal consistency of the plan, 26 pursuant to application L-5381-19A and companion land use Ordinance 27 2019-600; and

28 WHEREAS, in order to ensure consistency of zoning district 29 with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan and the adopted companion Large-30 Scale land use amendment L-5381-19A, an application to rezone and 31 reclassify from Planned Unit Development (PUD) District (1999-751E) to Commercial Neighborhood (CN) and Residential Medium Density-A (RMD-A) Districts was filed by Zach Miller, Esq., on behalf of Mohammed N. Mona, the owner of approximately 15.10± acres of certain real property in Council District 7, as more particularly described in Section 1; and

6 WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department, in order to 7 ensure consistency of this zoning district with the 2030 8 Comprehensive Plan, has considered the rezoning and has rendered an 9 advisory opinion; and

10 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has considered the 11 application and has rendered an advisory opinion; and

WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning (LUZ) Committee after due notice held a public hearing and made its recommendation to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council after due notice held a public 15 hearing, taking into consideration the above recommendations as 16 17 well as all oral and written comments received during the public hearings, the Council finds that such rezoning is consistent with 18 19 the 2030 Comprehensive Plan adopted under the comprehensive planning ordinance for future development 20 of the City of 21 Jacksonville; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

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Section 1. Subject Property Location and Description. The approximately 15.10± acres (R.E. No. 044220-0000) are located in Council District 7 at 0 Dunn Avenue, between Armsdale Road and Blossom Ridge Drive, as more particularly described in **Exhibit 1**, dated September 25, 2019, and graphically depicted in **Exhibit 2**, both of which are **attached hereto** and incorporated herein by this reference (Subject Property).

30 Section 2. Owner and Applicant Description. The Subject 31 Property is owned by Mohammed N. Mona. The applicant is Zach

3 Section 3. Property Rezoned. The Subject Property, pursuant to adopted companion Large-Scale land use amendment 4 application L-5381-19A, is hereby rezoned and reclassified from 5 Planned Unit Development (PUD) District (1999-751-E) to Commercial 6 7 Neighborhood (CN) and Residential Medium Density-A (RMD-A) 8 Districts.

9 Section 4. Disclaimer. The rezoning granted herein shall 10 not be construed as an exemption from any other applicable local, state, or federal laws, regulations, requirements, permits or 11 approvals. All other applicable local, state or federal permits or 12 approvals shall be obtained before commencement of the development 13 14 or use and issuance of this rezoning is based upon acknowledgement, 15 representation and confirmation made by the applicant(s), owner(s), 16 developer(s) and/or any authorized agent(s) or designee(s) that the 17 subject business, development and/or use will be operated in strict compliance with all laws. Issuance of this rezoning does not 18 19 approve, promote or condone any practice or act that is prohibited 20 or restricted by any federal, state or local laws.

21 Section 5. Contingency. This rezoning shall not become 22 effective until 31 days after adoption of the companion Large-Scale 23 land use amendment unless challenged by the state land planning 24 agency; and further provided that if the companion Large-Scale land use amendment is challenged by the state land planning agency, this 25 26 rezoning shall not become effective until the state land planning agency or the Administration Commission issues a final order 27 28 determining the companion Large-Scale land use amendment is in compliance with Chapter 163, Florida Statutes. 29

30 Section 6. Effective Date. The enactment of this
31 Ordinance shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of
