A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING THE JACKSONVILLE SHARKS ON WINNING THE 2019 NATIONAL ARENA LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Sharks, founded in 2010, are an Arena Football team playing in the National Arena League (NAL) since 2017. The Sharks are a perennial powerhouse having won the inaugural NAL championship in 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Sharks 2019 team was led by multiple award winning players, including defensive lineman Nick Woodman who won the NAL 2019 awards for Defensive Rookie of the Year, Defensive Lineman of the Year, and Defensive Player of the year; kicker Brandon Behr who won Special Teams Player of the Year; and offensive lineman Derrick Zeigler who won Offensive Lineman of the Year. Additionally, the Sharks' front office and coaching staff won multiple awards in 2019, including Mascot of the Year, Best Dance Team, Best Medical Staff, Best Game Operations, Best Fan Base, and Best Franchise. James Fuller was awarded the Assistant Coach of the Year Award, and Siaha Burley was awarded the Head Coach of the Year Award; and

WHEREAS, the Sharks 2019 season was nearly perfect with a record of fifteen wins and only a single loss to the New York Streets in a high scoring game. The Sharks dominance in the NAL regular season continued into the 2019 playoffs where they defeated

the Columbus Lions with a score of 67-43 landing them a second NAL Championship appearance; and

WHEREAS, the Sharks faced the Carolina Cobras, a very strong team, in what proved to be a hard fought NAL Championship. The Sharks played hard in the first half, but trailed at the start of the second half by a score of 23-28. The game went back and forth, and the Sharks found themselves trailing with time running out. With only eleven seconds left on the clock, quarterback Mike Fafaul was able to find wide receiver Durron Neal with a pass in the end-zone to score what proved to be the game winning touchdown. The Cobras refused to go quietly and drove their way to the Sharks 6-yard line before the clock ran out giving the Sharks their second NAL championship victory; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

The City of Jacksonville hereby honors and commends the Jacksonville Sharks players, Head Coach Siaha Burley, the coaching staff, front office and the entire Sharks organization on their outstanding achievement in winning the 2019 National Arena League championship, and extends its very best wishes for continued success in the future.
