Α RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE ENGINEER VINCENT HARPER AND LIEUTENANT RAMON RESS FOR THEIR BRAVERY AND SELFLESSNESS IN AIDING CAPTAIN LATORRENCE NORRIS WHO WAS ATTACKED AND SEVERELY INJURED ΙN THE LINE OF DUTY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Vincent Harper has been serving the Jacksonville community for over a decade with the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department. Recently promoted to the rank of Engineer, Mr. Harper continues to serve the community as part of the Rescue 2 team. Ramon Ress is a Lieutenant with the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department serving the community as part of the Rescue 4 team; and

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2019, the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department was dispatched on what initially appeared as a routine medical transport call. Engineer Vincent Harper and Captain Latorrence Norris, a thirteen-year JFRD veteran, responded in Rescue 2 to the call and began to transport a 38 year-old male patient to the nearest hospital, UF Health Jacksonville. While on route to the hospital, the patient became aggressive and attacked Capt. Norris; and

WHEREAS, during the struggle, Eng. Harper, hearing Capt.
Norris' screams for help, pulled over the rescue unit and bravely

attempted to subdue the attacker. During the altercation, both Capt. Norris and Eng. Harper received stab wounds, but Capt. Norris was severely wounded. Eng. Harper was able to subdue the attacker long enough for the severely injured Capt. Norris to call for backup. The Fire Rescue Communications team dispatched another Fire and Rescue unit, contacted the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office, and crucially contacted UF Health to notify them of the situation. Lt. Ress arrived in the Rescue 4 unit and immediately helped Eng. Norris to subdue the attacker until the JSO officers arrived; and

WHEREAS, Eng. Harper and Lt. Ress' bravery and selflessness undoubtedly helped to save the life of Capt. Norris. Without the quick actions and determination to subdue the attacker by Eng. Harper, and the immediate assistance of Lt. Ress, this bad situation could have easily become a terrible tragedy; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby honors and commends Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Engineer Vincent Harper and Lieutenant Ramon Ress for their bravery and selflessness in aiding Captain Latorrence Norris who was attacked and severely injured in the line of duty, and for their continued service to the community with the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department. The City is extremely grateful for their brave and selfless response to the emergency situation.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
