Type of Action: Execution of Interlocal Agreement; authorization of Administration to execute the agreement; establishing oversight

Bill Summary: This bill authorizes the Mayor, or his designee, and the corporation secretary to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Interlocal Agreement between Duval County First Responder Agencies, the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (JSO) and the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department (JFRD). Oversight shall be provided by JSO.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to authorize the execution of the Agreement. Section 365.179, 30 Florida Statutes, requires direct radio communications between 9-1-1 Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP) and first responders. It also requires the Sheriff to facilitate the development and execution of a written interlocal agreement between all primary first responders within the county. The JSO PSAP and the JFRD PSAP will provide notice by radio of a public safety emergency directly to the on-duty personnel of the other referenced PSAP when the other agency has not provided primary dispatch functions concerning the agency.

Policy Impact Area: JSO, JFRD, first responders, 9-1-1 dispatch services

Fiscal Impact: No financial impacts are anticipated.
