Bill Summary: The bill appropriates funds in the sum of \$22,500.00 to establish the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office SMART Motorcycle Program and will cover expenses for overtime salaries and benefits for officers, printed materials, and traffic cones for civilian motorcycle training classes. The transfer of these funds is as follows:
