With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

The Equestrian Center Grants Account shall be created pursuant to Section 111.600, Ordinance Code, and any equestrian center grant award funded from this account shall not require further City Council.

Section 7. Amending the Tourist Development Council Grant Guidelines. The Grant Guidelines are hereby amended as provided in Revised Exhibit 3, Rev Grant Guidelines, November 18, 2019 -NCSPHS" attached hereto. Unless otherwise provided in ordinance, any additional amendments to the Grant Guidelines shall require approval by the City Council.

Such editorial changes and any others necessary to make the Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein, and changes to the Ordinance Code shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

Section 9. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
