5 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE  
6 JACKSONVILLE ETHICS COMMISSION TO EXECUTE AND  
7 DELIVER A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE EMPLOYMENT  
8 CONTRACT BETWEEN THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR,  
9 OFFICE OF ETHICS COMPLIANCE AND OVERSIGHT AND  
10 JACKSONVILLE ETHICS COMMISSION IN ORDER TO  
11 REMOVE THE RESTRICTION LIMITING THE EXECUTIVE  
12 DIRECTOR TO 25 WORK HOURS PER WEEK AND TO  
13 ALLOW THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REGULAR PART-TIME  
14 STATUS (50 HOURS PER PAY PERIOD), AS SET FORTH  
15 IN SECTION 116.1502 (B), *ORDINANCE CODE*;  
16 REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON  
17 INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Approval and authorization.** The City of  
21 Jacksonville hereby approves and authorizes the Chair of the  
22 Jacksonville Ethics Commission, or his or her designee, to execute  
23 and deliver a first amendment to the Employment Contract between  
24 the Executive Director, Office of Ethics Compliance and Oversight  
25 and Jacksonville Ethics Commission (the "First Amendment") in order  
26 to remove the restriction limiting the Executive Director to 25  
27 work hours per week and to allow the Executive Director regular  
28 part-time status (50 hours per pay period), as set forth in Section  
29 116.1502(b), *Ordinance Code*. A copy of the First Amendment is  
30 attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this  
31 reference.

1           **Section 2.           Requesting Emergency Passage upon Introduction**  
2 **pursuant to Council Rule 4.901.**     Emergency passage of this  
3 legislation upon introduction is requested.     The nature of the  
4 emergency is that by restricting the Executive Director to 25 hours  
5 per week, the Employment Contract reduces the Executive Director's  
6 ability to meet the demands of services provided to JEA. Section  
7 116.1502(b), *Ordinance Code*, which allows a part-time employee to  
8 work 50 hours per pay period, allows the Executive Director to  
9 perform more flexibly and efficiently.

10           **Section 3.           Effective Date.**     This ordinance shall become  
11 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
12 without the Mayor's signature.
