Project Description

Project: Lighting and Other Artistic Enhancement of Roosevelt Blvd Overpass at Edgewood Avenue

Neighborhoods: Murray Hill, Avondale and Riverside

Management: Art in Public Places (APP) Program through the Cultural Council of Greater Jacksonville, Inc.

Collaboration: Florida FDOT, City of Jacksonville Public Works, Murray Hill Preservation Association, Riverside-Avondale Preservation, Art in Public Places Committee.

Appropriation to Roosevelt/Edgewood Artwork & Lighting Project \$45,000 for Artist Fees and Materials \$5,000 for Long-term Maintenance (10% set aside is required by Chapter 126, Part 9, Ordinance Code)

As part of the 2019 - 2022 FDOT project to improve Edgewood Avenue, the Roosevelt Boulevard overpass will be cleaned and painted. Crosswalks and lighting will be improved for pedestrians on Edgewood Avenue passing under Roosevelt Avenue.

In coordination with FDOT, an artist will be hired to work with the communities and design a computer controlled system to light the pedestrian areas and the ceiling of the roadway underpass. FDOT will be provide the electrical infrastructure for the LED lighting fixtures that will transform the dark, unsafe passage into a colorful work of art with high level of lights for safety.

With the cleaned overpass, additional artist(s) will be commissioned to paint large scale murals facing the Murray Hill Business District and facing Avondale.

Experienced lighting artist Bill Fitzgibbons of San Antonio, Texas, was selected by an Artist Selection Panel. The muralists will be selected at later date.

The Cultural Council of Greater Jacksonville, Inc., on behalf of the City, will secure the approval the FDOT for the design. After design approval, a memo of understanding regarding maintenance and removal will be approved administratively and executed by the Mayor pursuant to the pending legislation.
