BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 1. Approval and authorization. The City of Jacksonville hereby approves and authorizes the Chair of Jacksonville Ethics Commission, or his or her designee, to execute and deliver a first amendment to the Employment Contract between the Executive Director, Office of Ethics, Compliance and Oversight and the Jacksonville Ethics Commission (the "First Amendment") in order to remove the restriction limiting the Executive Director to 25 work hours per week and to allow the Executive Director regular part-time status (50 hours per pay period), as set forth in Section 116.1502(b), Ordinance Code. A copy of the First Amendment is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this

reference.

pursuant to Council Rule 4.901. Emergency passage of this legislation upon introduction is requested. The nature of the emergency is that by restricting the Executive Director to 25 hours per week, the Employment Contract reduces the Executive Director's ability to meet the demands of services provided to JEA. Section 116.1502(b), Ordinance Code, which allows a part-time employee to work 50 hours per pay period, allows the Executive Director to perform more flexibly and efficiently.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
