AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR DISCLAIMING AN UNOPENED AND UNIMPROVED PORTION OF THE OAK STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY, ESTABLISHED IN THE SUPPLEMENTARY PLAT TO RIVERSIDE, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF AS RECORDED IN DEED BOOK "Q", PAGE 434 OF THE FORMER PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7, AT THE REQUEST OF THE DOWNTOWN INVESTMENT AUTHORITY; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Closure and Abandonment. An unimproved and unopened portion of the Oak Street right-of-way, established in the supplementary plat to Riverside, according to the plat thereof as recorded in Deed Book "Q", Page 434 of the former public records of Duval County, in Council District 7, the description of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference (see R.E. # 090059-0000 for location purposes), is hereby closed and abandoned and/or disclaimed as a right-of-way at the request of the Downtown Investment Authority (the "Applicant"). There are no city, state, or other agency objections to this closure request. The City owns the adjacent property to the abandoned right-of-way. No closure application fee has been paid as Applicant is exempt from the fee.

Section 2. Purpose. Applicant has requested the closure

to facilitate the development of the right-of-way to be closed and the adjacent property pursuant to the Redevelopment Agreement between the City and Blue Cross and Blue Shield ("Redevelopment Agreement") previously authorized by Ordinance 2019-626-E.

Section 3. Requesting one cycle emergency passage pursuant to Council Rules 4.901 Emergency. One Cycle Emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is to allow Grantor to close on the purchase of the property in accordance with the time frames set forth in the Redevelopment Agreement so as to avoid any construction delays related to the construction of the parking garage as set forth in the Redevelopment Agreement.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
