Bill Summary: This bill approves and authorizes the execution and delivery of the First Amendment to the Employment Contract between the Jacksonville Ethics Commission and the Executive Director of the Office of Ethics Compliance and Oversight. The bill requests emergency passage upon introduction.

Background Information: The current employment contract restricts the Executive Director to 25 hours per week. The time restraint is limiting the Executive Director's ability to meet the service demands regarding JEA. The bill will remove the 25 hours per week requirement and allow the Executive Director to work as a regular part-time employee. As outlined in Section 116.1502(b), *Ordinance Code*, a part-time employee is entitled to work 50 hours per pay period. The emergency passage is necessary for the Executive Director to meet the demands of services provided to JEA.

Policy Impact Area: Employment contract, Jacksonville Ethics Commission

Fiscal Impact: The Executive Director part-time hourly rate is \$93.00 per hour.
